**Bill George Named Mayo Clinic Representative to Destination Medical Center Corp. Board
DMCC Board to Serve as Oversight Body to DMC Project**

ROCHESTER, Minn. — Mayo Clinic announced today that Bill George, a member of the [Mayo Clinic Board of Trustees](#) and former chairman and CEO of Medtronic, has accepted an appointment to represent Mayo Clinic on the Destination Medical Center Corporation (DMCC) Board. The DMCC was created as part of the [Destination Medical Center \(DMC\) legislation](#) passed in May and serves as the public governing board overseeing implementation of DMC. The law outlines the appointments of the eight members of the DMCC Board: Gov. Mark Dayton appoints four, the city of Rochester, two; Olmsted County, one and Mayo Clinic, one.

George is a professor of management practice at Harvard Business School and a director on the boards of ExxonMobil and Goldman Sachs. He is also an author and commentator.

“Bill George brings a wealth of experience to the DMCC, having led one of the most respected global medical companies in the world,” says [John Noseworthy, M.D.](#), Mayo Clinic president and CEO. “We are thrilled that Bill will serve as Mayo Clinic’s representative on the board. Bill’s experience and expertise will be a critical asset to the work of helping shape the DMC vision and building the exciting future of Rochester and Mayo Clinic in Minnesota.”

“Mayo Clinic’s decision to invest several billion dollars over the next 20 years and establish its global DMC in Minnesota presents an unprecedented opportunity for our state and the Rochester area specifically,” George says. “I am grateful for the opportunity to serve on the DMCC advisory board and look forward to working with the governor’s appointees and the Rochester and county leaders to establish the best path for DMC and the state of Minnesota.”
