Dr. Buskirk is Professor of Radiation Oncology and Chair of the Department of Radiation Oncology at Mayo Clinic in Florida. In his 30 years at Mayo Clinic, he has practiced at both Mayo Clinic in Rochester and Mayo Clinic in Florida and has served on numerous Mayo Clinic committees and professional societies.

Dr. Buskirk is Chair of the Personnel Coordinating Committee and is Vice Chair of the Executive Operations Team in Florida. He also is Chair of the Department of Radiation Oncology in Florida and a member of the Diversity and Inclusion Oversight Committee. He is the current Chair for the section of Radiation Oncology of the Florida Radiologic Society and has served as a counselor to the American College of Radiology. He is certified by the American Board of Radiology and has served as a reviewing editor for scientific journals.

Dr. Buskirk completed his internship and residency at Mayo Clinic and joined the staff in 1985. He is a graduate of the University of Nebraska College of Medicine. He has been awarded Fellowship within the American College of Radiology and is listed in The Best Doctors in America. He is the Residency Associate Program Director of the Radiation Oncology Residency Program and is author or co-author of numerous publications. His primary research interest is in the treatment of prostate cancer with radiation therapy.
