Vivien Williams	After all, they spend much of their time sniffing and tasting, ah, things. So their mouths may have bacteria such as e coli or salmonella in them.
Vivien Williams	So theoretically, contracting something is possible, and Dr. Tosh says don't let dogs lick your wounds.
Vivien Williams	Now, there is a theory that suggests exposure to dog germs is actually good for you.
