

MAYO CLINIC 2021 FACT SHEET Feb. 28, 2022

Mayo Clinic provided compassionate care for more than 1.4 million patients in 2021.

- Mayo cared for patients from every U.S. state and 139 countries.
- Mayo cared for a record number of patients in 2021, with hospital census averaging 2,100 patients per week 8.1% higher than in 2020.
- Mayo performed 137,000 surgeries and 1,740 solid organ transplants.
- More than 1 million outpatient virtual appointments were provided.
- Mayo staff provided 4,902 inpatient and acute care video consultations.
- More than 8,500 patients were enrolled in remote patient monitoring.
- The Mayo Clinic Advanced Care at Home Program admitted 1,255 patients for comprehensive 24/7 remote care at home.
- Mayo Clinic Health System's mobile health clinic, which began service in July 2021, provided nearly 1,000 patient visits and logged nearly 10,000 miles of travel among rural communities.
- Patients initiated nearly 4.2 million secure messages for medical advice through Patient Online Services.

Mayo Clinic has more than 73,000 staff members — all of whom are committed to patient-centered care, research and education.

- As of Dec. 31, 2021, Mayo Clinic's staff consisted of 66,300 allied health staff members; 7,300 physicians and clinical residents; and 2,740 clinical residents, research fellows and associates.
- Mayo Clinic in Arizona had 9,000 staff members.
- Mayo Clinic in Florida had 8,350 staff members.
- Mayo Clinic in Rochester had 40,950 staff members.
- Mayo Clinic Health System had 15,300 staff members.

Mayo Clinic has helped lead the global response to COVID-19.

- Mayo Clinic cared for 160,000 patients with COVID-19 in 2021.
- Mayo tested more than 1.1 million people for COVID-19.
- Mayo staff administered more than a half-million COVID-19 vaccinations.
- Mayo staff administered more than 19,000 monoclonal antibody infusions for patients with COVID-19.
- Mayo Clinic Laboratories, which serves health care professionals and clients in 60 countries, performed more than 2.4 million COVID-19 tests in 2021 and more than 27 million tests of all types.

Mayo Clinic expenditures for vital research exceeded \$1 billion in 2021.

- More than 4,500 Mayo staff members were involved in research activities.
- More than 1 million square feet of space was dedicated to research.
- More than 9,300 Institutional Review Board-approved studies were active.
- Active clinical trials at Mayo increased to 2,889, compared to 2,763 in 2020.



- Investigational new drugs developed by Mayo researchers increased to 87 42% more than five years ago.
- Mayo researchers and scientists published 13,697 articles in peer-reviewed publications 25.4% more than in 2020.

Mayo spent more than \$416 million in 2021 on its educational mission.

- Education at Mayo Clinic College of Medicine and Science brings together world-class clinical talent, a commitment to academic excellence and unparalleled research capabilities.
- Mayo Clinic Alix School of Medicine is ranked as one of the top medical schools in the U.S. and is recognized as a transformative leader in biomedical education.

Mayo Clinic expanded its international presence and services in 2021.

- Internationally, Mayo Clinic is building an integrated global health care network that enables care locally while providing access to knowledge and skills to care for patients with serious or complex conditions.
- Mayo Clinic Healthcare in London added these specialties, including cardiology, gastroenterology and pulmonary medicine.
- In Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates, Mayo Clinic operates the 732-bed Sheikh Shakhbout Medical City. This is a joint venture with Abu Dhabi Health Services Co.
- Mayo Clinic Care Network has more than 45 member organizations around the world. Mayo Clinic
 Care Network members are independent institutions that benefit from special access to Mayo Clinic's
 knowledge and expertise.

Mayo Clinic reinvests to benefit patients and staff, and the communities it serves.

- Mayo invested a record \$880 million in capital projects in 2021 to benefit patient care, improve facilities for patients and staff, and advance its research and education missions.
- Mayo contributed over \$11.5 million in 2021 to support hundreds of nonprofit organizations that support communities that Mayo serves, including more than \$500,000 during the holidays to fund grants to 80 nonprofit organizations across all communities where Mayo staff members live and work.
